

**Testbed:** Through our partners we intend to create the ecosystem to accelerate the growth of companies offering smart city solutions that could be deployed across those cities participating in the Global TWIN CITIES Initiative as well as in a post-war Ukraine. The WSCF is seeking to nurture a series Unicorn Businesses through our testbeds.

**Fund:** OXYGEN Fund is a private investment fund and is established as a special purpose fund invested in projects carried out for The Global TWIN CITIES Initiative.
